MROO represents over 31,000 OMERS pensioners across the province, and grows every day. Celebrating 40 years in 2017, MROO has been a successful non-profit member-driven advocate since 1977 working on behalf of retirees and future retirees who are members of OMERS.

- We have retiree <u>representation on both OMERS Boards</u> giving us the influence to lobby OMERS and government agencies
- Our advocacy focuses on the governance, design, and sustainability of the OMERS plan; the adequacy of retirement income in the province; health care issues and personal supports for seniors; and we fiercely defend the preservation of the defined-benefit pension plans
- We were instrumental in improving OMERS survivor pensions for spouses and inflation indexing, and more recently, the introduction of Additional Voluntary Contributions known as AVCs.
- We continue to work with OMERS to continue as today's award-winning service organization

- An annual general meeting in each of 9 zones to keep our members abreast of issues relating to retirees
